Complaint Committee Report

On January 28th, 2015 the Kentucky Commission on Proprietary Education Complaint Committee met to review the Complaint of **Seydou Talla vs. Truck America Training** (TAT), Shepherdsville, KY. Based on the evidence before it the Committee determined as follows:

The documentation submitted by Mr. Talla in the Complaint did not support a reimbursement of monies paid for tuition. Therefore, the Committee recommends that Truck America Training allow Mr. Talla to complete the 30 hours of training remaining on his contract with the school and assist him in scheduling and taking the final test needed to complete the program requirements. If Mr. Talla wishes to pursue completion of the program and the taking of the final exam, he is to contact Truck America Training and make arrangements to do so within 10 days of receipt of the letter that will be mailed to him from the Commission staff.

Other Business

Title IV funding – Legal staff sent the US Department of Education various documents to determine if a statutory or regulatory change is necessary in order for KCPE licensed institutions to continue to receive title IV funding.
